- 1. Rhonda shared the IASSIDD SIRG information and mission statements. Minutes from the previous AGM were shared and approved.
- 2. Members were encouraged to join ResearchGate for regular SIRG updates if not already a member.
- 3. IASSIDD will hold a year long congress in 2022 with each SIRG taking a month and organising an event. The DS SIRG will select October 2022 to coincide with Down syndrome awareness month. A webinar will be planned with a focus on collaborating with co-researchers with Down syndrome.
- 4. The planned three-day workshop for researchers in Zambia funded by the British Academy is currently on hold due to COVID-19 restrictions.
